

**BYLAW NO. 934  
OF THE TOWN OF SPIRIT RIVER**

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF SPIRIT RIVER IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE LAND USE BYLAW NO. 901, BEING THE TOWN OF SPIRIT RIVER LAND USE BYLAW.

WHEREAS, it is deemed and proper to the provisions section 7 and 8 of Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, R.S.A. 2010 and the Amendments thereto, that Council has passed a Bylaw respecting the use of land.

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Council deems has the authority to amend the Land Use Bylaw No. 901;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Spirit River duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. Section 7-2 Accessory Buildings shall be change to include: "6. any accessory building used for the purpose of a garage and with a rear entrance shall have a 20 foot rear setback and with a side or front entrance shall have a 5 foot rear setback."

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon the date of final reading thereof.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 17<sup>th</sup> DAY OF March, 2014.
