

BYLAW NO. 928
of the TOWN OF SPIRIT RIVER
(herein referred to as "the Municipality")
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A Bylaw of the Town of Spirit River to authorize a special recreational services tax levied for the 2013 taxation year against each parcel of land within the Town of Spirit River, Alberta.

WHEREAS, The Town of Spirit River, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of Section 382 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, deems it necessary to provide a bylaw for the levy of a recreational services special tax to cover the costs of construction, maintenance, and operation of the recreational facilities in Spirit River, AB.

AND WHEREAS, the entire Town of Spirit River will benefit from such recreational services

THEREFORE, based on the 2013 budget, the estimated cost of the construction, maintenance and operation of the recreational facilities will be \$299,281.00, which includes \$41,156.00 for amortization.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Act, the Council of Spirit River, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows,

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized and directed to levy \$50.00 per parcel of land within the Town of Spirit River, AB.
2. That this special tax be in addition to all other taxes and rates.

SHORT TITLE

3. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Town of Spirit River Recreational Services Tax".


This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading thereof.
