

BYLAW # 921

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SPIRIT RIVER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPOINTING A CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

WHEREAS Pursuant to section 205 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 with Amendments to June 14, 2007, Council of the Town of Spirit River must establish a position of Chief Administrative Officer.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Town of Spirit River, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. Deedra Deveau is hereby appointed Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Spirit River, in the Province of Alberta.
2. The Chief Administrative Officer's duties shall be as outlined in the Municipal Government Act, Town of Spirit River Position Description and such other as requested by Council, within the limitations of Council.
3. The Chief Administrative Officer is appointed at the pleasure of Council, shall hold office continuous at the pleasure of Council and be subject to an agreed-upon probation period.
4. The appointment, suspension and/or revocation is subject to Section 206 of the Municipal Government Act.
5. The Chief Administrative Officer, in consideration of the duties and responsibilities relating to the position shall be entitled to receive a fair and equitable salary and employee benefits as outlined in the salary grid and agreed upon by the personal services contract of employment.
6. This appointment to be effective October 4, 2011.
